A Word About the Water Supply.

Our water treatment plant was built to suit the needs of a small resort community. The growth of the community did not take into consideration those additional water needs.

That means we do not have the capacity for the extra load when people use our potable water supply to fill their pools, water their lawns, and other unforeseen uses, particularly during the busy weekends.

It would be nice to be able to upgrade the system; however, to do so costs far more money than our tax base can possibly cover, and cannot be done in time for this season.

We would ask then, that you conserve water usage whenever possible so that everyone can have access to potable water throughout the season!!



A Message About Our Water..

Suggestions to conserve water.

- Do not use water to defrost food.
- Do not leave water running to rinse dishes.
- Consider harvesting rain water, it is great for your plants and makes your hair very soft.
- Don't fill swimming pools with potable water.
